

## Project 347: Village School Toilet Refurbishment

**Client:** Bobbing Village School, Sittingbourne

**Programme:** 6 Weeks

**Construction Details:** Carpentry, Cubicles, Decorating, Decoration, Floor Coverings, Flooring, Plastering, Plumbing, Refurbishment, Sanitary Ware, School Improvement, Suspended Ceilings, Toilet Cubicles, Toilet Refurbishment

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## **Village School Toilet Refurbishment**

A local village school required toilet refurbishment works. The school's previous year 1 and 2 toilet facilities consisted of two small separate toilet blocks. The boys and girls toilets were cramped and needed modernising. The school asked if it was possible to turn the two small sets of toilets into one larger open space. We designed an area that could be used as a unisex toilet, using cubicles and vanity unit only. Any urinals were to be removed.

### **Creating a Larger Space**

The school liked our proposal and gave us the go ahead to carry out the works. We removed the wall that separated the boys and girls toilets. We also removed the front wall which included the original entrance doors. The removal of both walls created a larger area which allowed us to install more toilet cubicles than would have been previously possible. The improved size also meant that we could also install a central vanity unit consisting of four sinks. A new suspended with LED lighting panels was also installed.

The bright colours picked by the school added to the new toilets and gives the area a light and spacious feel.

### **Year R Toilet Refurbishment**

In addition to the year one and two toilets, we were also asked to refurbish the year R toilets. This was simpler task which included changing the toilets, cubicles and flooring. All pipework and cisterns were hidden behind easily accessible rear paneling. This tidies up the area and is easier to keep clean. We also added a new vanity unit which also hides all pipework and allows for easy cleaning.

The school was extremely happy with the final results and now have bright, clean open areas.
